KRCB 104.9FM adds *Tiny Desk Radio* to weekly schedule



Northern California Public Media is proud to announce that the new NPR program ***Tiny Desk Radio*** will be added to the weekly programming schedule on KRCB 104.9FM starting Sunday, May 4th at 6pm.

Tiny Desk Radio packages the popular *Tiny Desk Concerts* into an hour-long broadcast program hosted by NPR's Bobby Carter and Anamaria Sayre. NPR's *Tiny Desk* is a singular space for music discovery — the discovery of new artists, or the discovery of your favorite artists in a new light. ***Tiny Desk Radio*** will reflect that magic in its music and storytelling. Listeners will be enchanted by intimate performances





from up-and-coming acts to the most iconic artists of our time, from Ca7riel & Paco Amoroso to Chaka Khan.

Tiny Desk Concerts have had a staggering impact on fans of all ages and backgrounds across the country. This year, the *Tiny Desk Contest* received more entries than ever before from up-and-coming artists from nearly every U.S. state and territory. The numbers speak for themselves:

- NPR Music on YouTube has an extraordinary 11 million Subscribers and 3.6 billion views through its *Tiny Desk Concert* videos.
- *Tiny Desk* has global recognition with over 300K YouTube views for the *Tiny Desk Korea* and *Tiny Desk Japan* concert series.
- The NPR Audience Insights team's look at the *Tiny Desk Concerts* brand from 2022 to 2024 found that YouTube users see the concerts as high-quality and irreplaceable.

KRCB has encouraged local musicians to enter the *Tiny Desk Contest* each year and partnered with Lagunitas Brewing Company to host the *Tiny Desk Contest on the Road* series at their venue in Petaluma. This year there were 14 local entries.
